DESCRIPTION

SikaPlast® GL 3251 is an innovative second generation superplasticizer based on polycarboxylic ether (PCE) polymers and is specially engineered for ready-mixed concrete.

SikaPlast® GL 3251 is differentiated from conventional superplasticisers, such as those based on sulphonated naphthalene formaldehyde condensate in that it is based on a unique carboxylic ether polymer with long lateral chains. This greatly improves cement dispersion. At the start of the mixing process the same electrostatic dispersion occurs but the presence of the lateral chains, linked to the polymer backbone, generate a steric hindrance which stabilises the cement particles capacity to separate and disperse. This mechanism provides flowable concrete with greatly reduced water demand.

Compatibility	SikaPlast® GL 3251 is not compatible with Sikament RB superplasticizers. SikaPlast® GL 3251 is suitable for mixes containing: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Microsilica (Silica Fume)• Fly Ash (PFA)• GGBS (ground granulated blast furnace slag)
Recommended Dosage	The normally recommended dosage rate of SikaPlast® GL 3251 is: 0.5 to 1.5 litre per 100kg of total cementitious material. Other dosages may be recommended in special cases according to the specific site conditions. In this case, please consult our Technical Services Department for advice.
Dispensing	SikaPlast® GL 3251 is a ready-to-use admixture to be added to the concrete as a separate component. Optimal result is obtained if SikaPlast® GL 3251 is poured into the concrete mix right after the addition of the first 80% of the mixing water, i.e. when all solids are wetted. Avoid adding the admixture to the dry aggregates.
